Dear Friends:

2012 has been a landmark year for Methodist Home for Nursing and Rehabilitation. We have accomplished several projects throughout the year, one of which was the final completion of our \$10 million dollar construction project. Our residents enjoyed a wonderfully cool summer thanks to our new cooling system and the sub-acute rehabilitation unit is spectacular with the new flooring and furniture. All the day rooms have been renovated and the new furnishings are beautiful. The renovation of both elevators has also been completed. We are expanding our out-patient rehabilitation program and have provided a satellite rehab room located on the 4th floor sub-acute unit.

Methodist Home was able to be fully operational with no loss of power or service during Hurricane Sandy. We were able to accommodate several residents from facilities which were evacuated during the storm. We worked closely with these hospitals and the Department of Health during the entire process and we are very grateful to our dedicated staff for all their hard work and dedication during the storm.

Morrison Management Specialists Food Service Company joined Methodist Home for Nursing and Rehabilitation in February 2012. Morrison has implemented a number of very innovative programs such as monthly food and nutrition events for our residents, resident food committees, nutrition boards featuring monthly super foods and healthy food choices, a resident cook book as well as annual satisfaction surveys. Decentralized dining has been implemented on the Sub-acute Rehab unit which promotes socialization and offers the residents a choice of entrees. This dining experience helps enhance the quality of the resident's experience during their short-term stay at Methodist Home.

Our annual Gala was held this past year at the Glen Island Harbour Club in New Rochelle and it was again a great success. We extend our heartfelt gratitude to all our friends and supporters who gave so generously for our most important fundraiser of the year.

We would also like to take this opportunity to welcome our new CFO, Ilana Avinari to Methodist Home. Mrs. Avinari brings with her twelve years of finance and auditing experience and we look forward to a successful collaboration.

Among the many events during the year, one we are especially proud of, was the Coat Drive we held in conjunction with New York Cares. We collected over 60 warm coats which were distributed throughout NYC. We would like to extend our gratitude to those who contributed to this special event.

Methodist Home for Nursing and Rehabilitation continues to maintain a strong collaborative relationship with our neighbor and friend Manhattan College as well as other academic institutions in the area.
